

## Key Symbolism ★ The Moon Card

### Traditional Interpretations

#### 1. Sun & Moon

Full moon, half moon and sun are merged into one. The sun acts as the outer self and life force, while the moon represents intuition and the subconscious.

Full moon and crescent moon shape represent the constant ever-changing cycle of emotions as time passes by.

#### 2. Dog & Wolf

Dog = Tamed 🌞 Wolf = Wild

The pair represents the struggle between societal conditioning (dog) and true, raw intuition (wolf). The constant battle between our primal and civilized selves.



#### 3. Crayfish

Crustacean = age old feelings and instincts. The need to deal with things head on or they might slip away again into the subconscious unresolved.

#### 5. Tower / Gates of Heaven

A gateway to another realm. Entrance to a new, higher state of consciousness and the boundary between the conscious and unconscious.

#### 4. Drops Of Gold

15 golden drops in the form of the hebrew letter J form glittering drops. To represent the in-between state and the wondering of souls.

#### 6. The Long Road

The path of life. A winding journey of dreams and loss.

#### 7. The Blue Sky

The subconscious mind and the quiet of the unseen.

# Key Symbolism ★ The Moon Card

## My Version Of The Moon

### 1. The Sun & Moon

Introspective, left side facing moon to represent going inwards.

Behind both moons the sun is hidden yet aspects of it show through the golden stars and dots..

### 2. The Border & Towers

The border connects with both the moon & sun and is decorated with intricate Portuguese patterns. The two towers are open with the castle (subconscious) behind. Showing the need to combine both the subconscious and conscious and also the ladies ability to step away at any time. A message to not be afraid of the subconscious but to use it as a pathway to growth.

### 3. The Castle

A journey inwards into soul.

### 4. The Dog

A youthful energetic, french bulldog that accompanies the lady on the long journey ahead. (Inspired by my mum's puppy!)

5. **The Lady** Wearing a long blue gown to show working with throat chakra.



### 6. The Wolf

Similar to traditional tarot the wolf is howling right at the moon. A reminder to face whatever is coming up and to not hide from it.

### 7. The Crayfish

Biting and going up the women's dress to show facing things.

8. **The Pond** Murky and muddy to show mixed feelings and emotions
